Arrival and Departure

Sites are available from 12pm and accommodation is available from 2pm. Check-out time is 10am.

Office Hours

Office hours are 9am-5pm, 7 days a week.

Amenities/Laundry/Camp Kitchen

Coin operated washing machines and dryers are available for guest use. Please report any faults to the office immediately.

Boom Gates

Upon arrival and payment a pin number for the boom gate will be provided to the site holder. Pin numbers will not be issued to any other person.

Private Property

Management does not accept any liability for loss or damage to any caravan, vehicle, tent or lost property in the park. Please make sure you secure all valuables. Lost property can be handed into the office and will be held for two weeks.

Cleanliness

Please ensure that campsites and accommodation are left clean and tidy on departure. Including removing all rubbish from cabins and sites. Cleaning charges may apply if sites/ cabins are left in an unreasonable condition.

Garbage

Wheelie bins are situated throughout the park and are emptied daily during peak periods. Please separate garbage and recycling. Please do not move bins from their location.

Security

Security personnel are on duty during the Christmas school holidays and weekends during February, March and April. Please contact the office if you have any concerns. All gates may be locked during the evening and reopened at 6am.

Visitors

All visitors must be registered at reception when entering the park. All visitors must vacate the park by 10pm.

Hazards and Incidents

Please report all hazards and incidents to reception.

Dogs

Dog owners must comply with the following conditions:

•Dogs must be kept on leash at all times within the park.

 $\boldsymbol{\cdot} \textsc{Dogs}$ must not be left unattended in the park and must be kept quiet.

•Dog owners agree to take full responsibility of any personal injury or damage caused by their dogs while within the confines of the park and agree to pay for any claims of compensation in relation to the dog's activities.

•Dogs will be kept off cabin furniture.

·Guests must clean up after their dogs.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- · A speed limit of 5kph (walking pace) must be observed at all times by all vehicles, bikes, skateboards and scooters, etc.
- · Excessive noise, unruly behaviour, vandalism, bad language, unreasonable disturbance or any other conduct which disturbs the peaceful and quiet enjoyment of any site will not be tolerated. Park quiet time is 10 pm to 7 am
- All fires must accord with CFA guidelines and be enclosed in an elevated fireplace. Fires are not to be left unsupervised and must be extinguished by 10.30pm. Please see management before lighting a fire.
- · All cars must register at the office prior to entering the park.
- · Persons under the age of 18 years must have adult supervision while in the park.
- · Children and infants must be accompanied by an adult while in the amenity block.
- A maximum of one caravan is permitted per site.
- · A maximum of six guests (excluding infants) are permitted per site. This can include no more than four adults.
- · All equipment and belongings, including caravan, tent and vehicles must be contained within site boundaries.

- · All drawbars must face the nearest park road for CFA access.
- · Please familiarise yourself with the park evacuation plan, which can be found throughout the park in all facilities.
- · All guests must comply with any total fire ban restrictions.
- The park BBQs are electric and can be used, however portable gas BBQs and stoves are not permitted on days of total fire ban.
- · In case of emergency, do not attempt to move your vehicle, caravan or tent.
